Description:	Berth Works
	During 2023, TasPorts has been undertaking works to enhance the safety of the Macquarie 4 & 5 berths for the berthing and mooring of vessels.
	Works have involved the installation of additional arch fenders at sections of both Macquarie 4 & 5 berths to provide two 70m berthing zones which provide improved standards of infrastructure for berthing and enhanced mooring practices.
	Following completion of the installation, Macquarie 4 & 5 Berths have been assessed to be able to continue to safely berth vessels of up to a Displacement of 50,000 Tonnes <u>and</u> a maximum of 300 metres Length Overall (LOA).
	Please note these revised vessel parameters which remain in effect until further notice.
	The standard Vessel Booking protocols remain the same as detailed in Section 2.3 of the Ports Procedures Manual.
