Together as leaders we recognise that our actions and responses matter and we will:



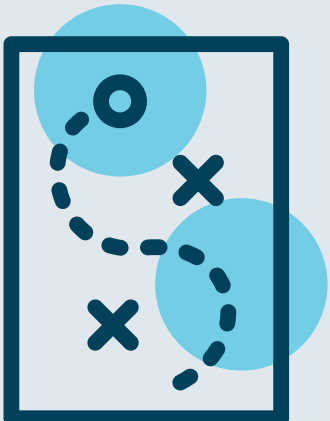

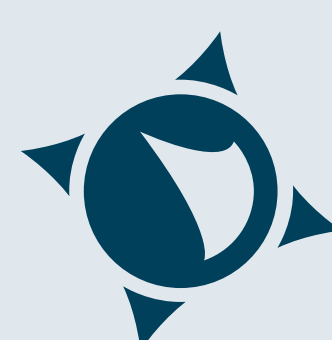

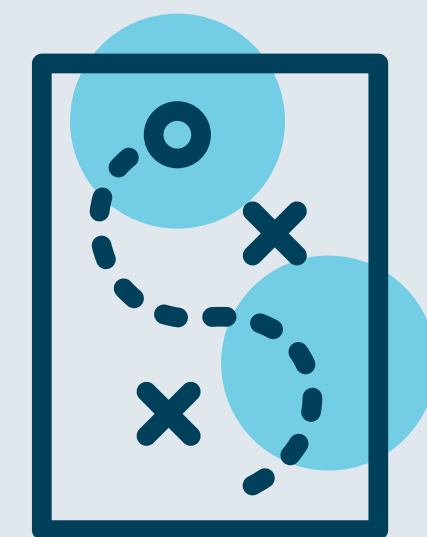
